10. Information Items / Updates

- a. CSX Property Appraisal: We are still in discussions with CSX, and now with a new person there. The latest discussion surrounds the ingress and egress for the access drive that MDOT closed. This property is worth about \$12,500, so we are hopeful that a purchase can be made. <u>Pickard</u> asked how much property Old Iron Bar & Grill owns near the railroad tracks, and Doug replied that if we get this property we would have it surveyed. Aside from a survey, it is difficult to tell within ten feet of orthophotography.
- b. Blanche Lake Park Docks, Bleachers, Horseshoe Pits: The docks are under construction now, and we are on schedule to install them in April. The used bleachers we purchased will go behind the ball diamond home plate in the spring. The horsehoe pits were constructed for an Eagle Scout project.
- c. Sidewalks: A supplemental request was submitted to The Fremont Area Community Foundation . Grant Public School is willing to cover up to \$3,000 towards these new sidewalks, and the City has an in-kind

donation also. Doug is hoping to meet with Lynne Robinson this week to discuss the need of these additional sidewalks.

d. Amphitheatre – grant project proposal: Several meetings have been held to gather support for this project. If we are able to get the grant, we will have the DPW mark out several possibly locations for everyone to see. We could go to Blanche Lake Park after a meeting and see which location would be best.
