<u>La Fave</u> commented that the lights affected will be replaced are currently high pressure sodium mercury vapor lights, at no cost to the City for this.

e. Ordinance #21-1 Dog Ordinance: Repealing Ord. #43 and amending Ord. #21-Consideration for acceptance of second reading.

**Motion:** Motion made by Pickard, second by Yeomans to approve second and final reading of Ordinance #21-1. <u>La Fave</u> commented that several people have stopped by or asked us about this ordinance, and they seemed satisfied enough since none of them are here tonight.

<u>Fett</u> discussed recent media attention surrounding pit bulls versus command dogs. Motion carried unanimously.

## 10. Information Items / Updates

- a. 2011-2012 FY Budget: Mayor Fett likes the budget that was presented. When it is compared to other area cities, our budget looks really good. Doug mentioned the decline in taxable value is 1.7%, and commented that we have lost \$21,000 in general operating revenues throughout the struggling economic times. He also commented on another version of the statutory revenue sharing formula we will be looking at. There will be three main areas scored, which will add up to 62.96% of what we used to receive, which is all we are budgeting for. If there is any remaining balance, we could receive an additional distribution later. We plan to allocate street lighting utility payments out of the roads and right-of-ways fund next fiscal year. Also, the Waste Water Treatment operating budget is nearly completed.
- b. Wind Turbine: We are still collecting data.
- c. Verizon cell tower: We are good to go, and they should be breaking ground any day now.
- d. RFP-Solid Waste: Our contract will be up in December. We will be including recycle bins and 2 dumpsters in the new contract at no additional cost.
- e. Safe Routes to School sidewalks grant: We are still waiting to hear from The Fremont Area Community Foundation on the engineering grant proposal of \$23,000 alone. If granted, we are probably looking at 2012-2013 to get this project done.
- f. DNRE-DTE grant: We set a date to pick up the trees, and we are trying to get some uniformity with placement. We will plan to plant these trees on the City clean-up volunteer day on Friday, May 20, 2011.
