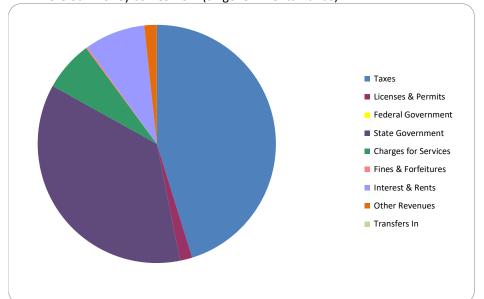

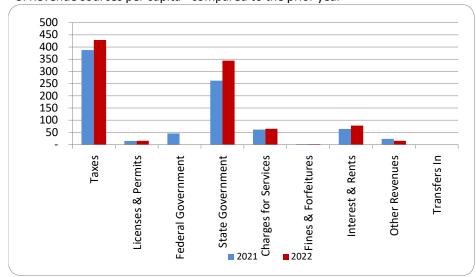

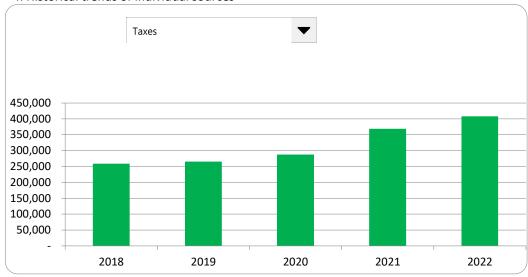

3. Revenue sources per capita - compared to the prior year



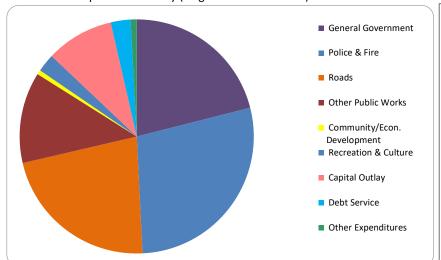

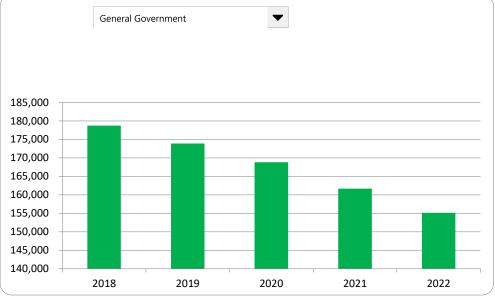

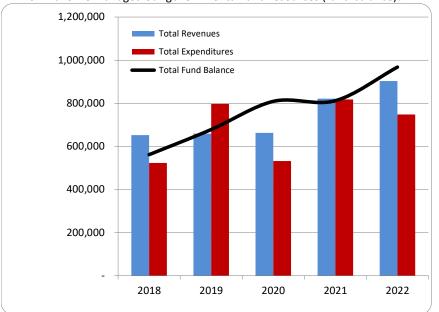

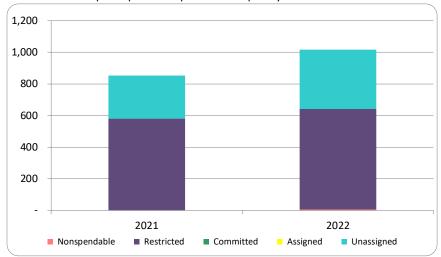

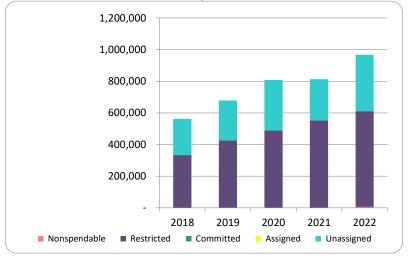

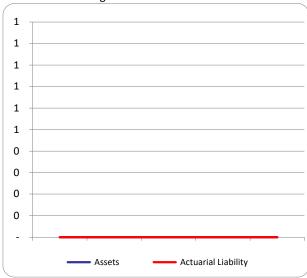

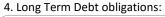


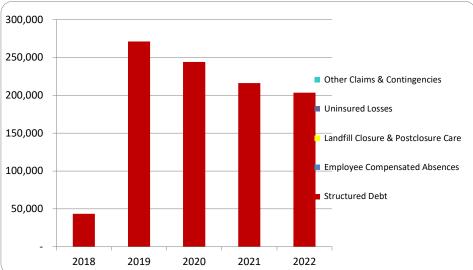
3. Percent funded - compared to the prior year



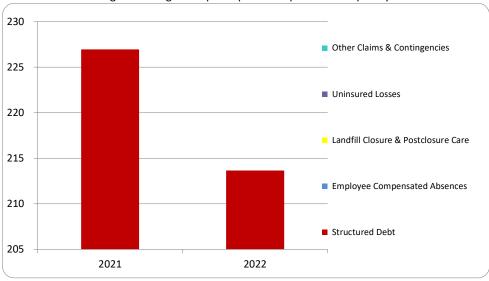








5. Debt & other long term obligations per capita - compared to the prior year
