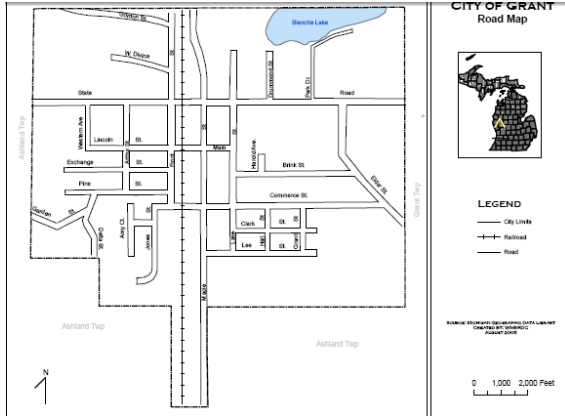


Welcome to the City of Grant!

CITY SERVICES

Water Service:

- The City provides water to all City residences.
- The City maintains the water lines from the main to the water shut off.

Your responsibilities:

- Keep the area of your residence where your meter is located free of vegetation to facilitate the meter being read.
- Maintain the water line from the shut off to your residence and within your home. Do not let your meter freeze in the winter!

Sanitary Sewer Service:

- The City provides sewer to all City residences.
- The City maintains the sewer main lines only.

Your responsibilities:

- Maintain the sewer lateral line from your residence to the main.
- Call the City DPW if your sewer line is plugged so we can determine where the blockage is located. If it is a system problem with the main line it is the City's responsibility. If it's determined to be a lateral issue it is your responsibility.

Yard Waste Pickup:

- Yard waste pickup occurs on the 1st and 15th of each month April thru November.

Snow Removal:

- November through March as needed.

Police/Public Safety:

- The City provides its own Police Department for protecting City residents. The Police Department is located at the City Office at 280 S. Maple St.

Fire/First Responders:

- The City is a member of a Joint Fire District with Ashland and Grant Township. The Fire Barn is located on W. State Rd.

Home Improvements:

- Homeowners should assume permits are required for all home improvements. Please call the Building/Zoning Administrator at (231) 834-7904 before you undertake any improvements.

Property Maintenance Code:

- Property owners are responsible for maintaining their house and yards to safety and appearance standards. Do not store the following outside your home:

interior furniture, unlicensed vehicles, garbage (not in appropriate containers) and construction debris.

- Fixing items like peeling paint, hanging gutters, broken porch steps, damaged roofs and broken windows is expected of homeowners.

Weed, Tall Grass and Tall Brush Control:

- Starting May 1st of each year homeowners are required to remove all tall weeds and grass from their property and the right of way in front of the property. Tall weeds and grass is anything over 10".

Traffic Control:

- Parking between the hours of 2 am and 6 am is prohibited on all streets and in the City for snow removal from November-March
