CITY OF GRANT ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 22 OF THE GRANT CITY CODE TO PROVIDE FOR A GENERAL PENALTY PROVISION

The City of Grant Ordains:

Ordinance No. 22 of the Grant City Code is hereby repealed and replaced in its entirety with the following amendment:

Ordinance No. 22 General Penalty.

Whenever, in these codified ordinances, in any technical or other code adopted by reference in these codified ordinances, in any rule, regulation or order promulgated or made under authority of any provision of these codified ordinances, or under authority of any technical or other code adopted by reference in these codified ordinances, or under authority of state law, an act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful or an offense or a civil infraction or a misdemeanor, or whenever the doing of any act is required or the failure to do any act is declared to be unlawful, where no specific penalty is otherwise provided, whosoever violates or fails to comply with any such provision shall be fined not more than five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or imprisoned not more than ninety days, or both, for each offense. A separate offense shall be deemed committed each day during or on which a violation or noncompliance occurs or continues, unless otherwise provided.

This ordinance shall become effective on June 11, 2001.

Commissioner Sorden moved the adoption of the foregoing Ordinance, which was supported by Commissioner Powell, and thereupon adopted by the City Commission of the City of Grant at a regular meeting held on May 21, 2001.
