### VII. PLAN REVIEW REQUIREMENTS

Plans and specification for new construction work, alteration, repair, expansion, addition, or modification work shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act No. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that architects or engineer's signature and seal.

**If a plan review is required it must be done before a permit can be issued!**

- Exception 1: Alterations and repair work determined by the Code Official to be minor in nature.
- Exception 2: Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00
- Exception 3: One-and-two family dwellings containing not more than 3,500 square feet of habitable building area.
- Exception 4: Buildings with a required plumbing fixture count less than 12.

**Please Note: A driver license number or a state ID number, for non-drivers, is required of the person signing a check!**

- \*\* Item #29-MOBILE HOME UNIT SITE: When item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee plus the number of unit sites.
- \*\*\* Item #5 & 30 FIXTURES, FLOOR DRAINS, SPECIAL DRAINS, WATER CONNECTED APPLIANCES INCLUDE **But Not** LIMITED TO: Water Closets, Sinks, Slop Sink, Drinking Fountain, Floor drain, Water Outlets, Bath tub, Emergency Eye Wash, Bidet, Condensate Drain, Roof Drain, Lavatories, Emergency Shower, Cuspidor, Washing Machine, Grease, Starch or Plaster Traps, Connections to Irrigation Systems, Shower Stalls, Laundry Tray, Urinal, Autopsy, Garbage Grinder, Dishwasher, Refrigerator, Water Heater, Water Softener, Any Water Connected Appliance
- \*\*\*\* Item #6-DOMESTIC WATER TREATMENT AND FILTERING EQUIPMENT: A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed, and the installation complies with the applicable code. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #4 @ \$5.00 each and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

**Plumbing Guidelines**  
**For**  
**Single & Doublewide Mobile Homes**

Inspection for Plumbing shall be done before installing the skirting of any kind. If skirting is installed before inspection, the skirting will be required to be removed for the inspection and reinstalled after approval has been given. A reinspection may result if skirting is installed before inspection has been completed. If you have any questions, please contact the Plumbing Inspector at (231) 689-7216, Monday, Wednesday or Friday, between 8:00 am & 9:00 am.

**SANITARY DRAINAGE**

1) CLEANOUTS

The cleanout shall be either inside or outside the building wall and shall be brought up to the finished ground level or basement floor level. Section 708.3.5

2) SOLVENT CEMENT JOINTS

Glued joints between different types of plastic pipe is prohibited. Section. 707.

EXAMPLE: Joints between ABS to PVC plastic for sanitary drainage shall be threaded [male to female] or with use of a fernco style boot.

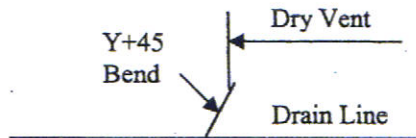
3) HANGER SPACING for PVC sanitary drainage shall be every four feet horizontally. Section 308.5

**VENTS**

1) VENT CONNECTION TO DRAINAGE SYSTEM

Every dry vent connecting to a horizontal drain shall connect above the centerline of the horizontal drain pipe! Section 905.3

EXAMPLE:



**TYPES OF WATER SUPPLY PIPE FOR HOMES**

- 1) Acrylonitrile butadiene styrene (ABS) plastic pipe
- 2) Copper or copper- alloy pipe
- 3) Further list of water service materials contained in TABLE 605.3 of 2003 code book

**PROTECTION OF WATER SERVICE TO MOBILE HOMES**

1. Water service piping ran through poured slab must have a valve installed above the slab.
2. Service pipe shall be wrapped with heat tape and insulated!
